Eco Tip:

Disposing of medication blister packs: The Superdrug Pharmacy in the Touchwood Centre has a partnership with several large pharmaceutical companies to ensure recycling of empty packs. This overcomes the problem of mixed recycling of both foil and plastic. There is a cardboard post box near the pharmacy counter with a slot to put them in. Please do not collect communal large quantities but use this for disposal of personal used-up medical packs.
